For M.A Telugu, M.A Applied Linguistics, M.Phil Telugu, M.Phil Linguistics, M.Phil History Culture & Archaeology and for P.G. Diploma Courses in Linguistics and Telugu Language Teaching, Travel & Tourism, Indian Management & Personality Development Admission will be through merit in qualifying examination. And for all other courses entrance will be conducted for 25% of marks and remaining 75% will be added from qualifying examination.

4. COURSES OFFERED IN DISTANCE MODE

1. M.A. ASTROLOGY (Jyotisham)

Eligibility : Any graduate or its equivalent degree from a recognized University with basic knowledge and aptitude for Astrology.

Duration : 2 years

Medium : Telugu & English

Course Fee : Rs.2,500/- per year + Rs.150/- towards postal charges.

US \$ 150 per year for candidates from abroad.

2. M.A. TELUGU

Eligibility : Any graduate with Telugu as second language or as optional, or its equivalent degree in Oriental Learning.

Duration : Two years

Course Fee : Rs.2,500/- per year + Rs.150/- towards Postal charges.

US \$ 150 per year for candidates from abroad.

3. M.A. SANSKRIT

Eligibility : Any graduate with any one of the modern or classical languages as second language or its equivalent degree in Oriental Learning.

Duration : Two years

Medium : Sanskrit / Telugu / English

Course Fee : Rs.2,500/- per year + Rs.150/- towards postal charges.

US \$ 150 per year for candidates from abroad.

4. MCJ (Master of Communication and Journalism)

Eligibility : Any graduate or an equivalent degree from a recognized University.

Duration : Two years (Integrated Course)

Medium : Telugu

Course Fee : Rs.4,000/- per year + Rs.150/- towards postal charges

US \$ 200 per year for candidates from abroad.

5. CERTIFICATE COURSE IN MODERN TELUGU

Eligibility : SSC or its equivalent examination.

This course is meant for those who do not know Telugu (useful for non-Telugus)

Duration : One year

Medium : English

Course Fee : Rs.475/-per year + Rs.150/- towards postal charges.

US \$ 30 for candidates from abroad.

6. SANGEETHA VISHARADA

Eligibility : should have completed 12 years of age at the time of admission.

Duration : four years

Medium : Telugu

Course Fee : Rs.400/- per year + Rs.150/- towards postal charges.

US \$ 30 for candidates from abroad.

5. HOSTEL FACILITY

The University maintains Hostels in Hyderabad, Rajahamundry, Srisailam and Kuchipudi Campuses for the benefit of its students. The University takes all precautions to provide all facilities at the hostels.

6. MEDICAL FACILITIES

A Doctor regularly visits the Hostel to Checkup the students at free of cost. The employees of the University are covered under mediclaim policy.

7. N.S.S.

The University has NSS unit which is headed by coordinator. The students of NSS will have special camps from time to time.

8. STUDENTS PLACEMENTS

The University arranges placement facilities for the students in Journalism and other courses.

9. ADMISSION TO FOREIGN STUDENTS

The University admits foreign students in various courses without any entrance test. There is a special provision for Telugu NRI's in all courses.

10. STUDENTS WELFARE AND OTHER ACTIVITIES

The University has appointed Dean, Students Affairs and also Students Welfare Officer to look after and coordinate various activities of the students and their welfare.
